

■DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this conference is to provide an educational opportunity for nurses to increase their knowledge and ability to accurately interpret a fetal monitor tracing.

The conference format will be the presentation of four generic cases using fetal monitoring tracings as a component of the case presentation.
